After Completing ASLdeafined - Reinforcement Class Activities

- **1.** Have students write out 10 of their favorite places to go on a piece of paper. Find a partner to work with. One person will fingerspell their list, and the partner will give it back in ASL.
- 2. Have students write out 3 sentences using words from lesson Fun Places to Go. Collect the papers. Then, randomly sign the sentences on the papers to the class. See if they can figure out what is being signed even though they may not know each sign.
